

### **Rural Women’s Empowerment through their improved vocational skills Development and Enhanced Access to Enterprises Opportunities funded By P&D-Government of Sindh**

Rural Women’s Empowerment through improved vocational skills, development and enhanced access to enterprises opportunities: Hamdam Foundation signed an agreement with Community Development Program CDP, Planning and Development (P&D) Government of Sindh to undertake skill development project titled “Rural Women’s Empowerment through their improved vocational skills Development and Enhanced Access to Enterprises Opportunities in TalukaSehwan District Jamshoro. HF provided training to 900 rural women under this program.

### **Enhancing Quality and Access to TVET for Employability supported by IRC.**

Hamdam foundation implemented a project entitled Enhancing Quality and Access to TVET for Employability at Taluka Johi District Dadu with the support of International Rescue committee-IRC, Sindh, Hamdam Foundation trained 300 right holders’ women and developed their market linkages. In this project the rural women and girls got tailoring and machine embroidery training. Each right holder has been awarded with certificate by STEVTA.

### **Social and Economic empowerment of socially excluded and economically deprived indigenous Ghera community (Scheduled Castes) though enhanced trade skills –USAID-TDEA**

In this project HF worked with USAID to enhance the Socio-Economic situation of indigenous ghera community by providing trade, and vocational skills to the ghera community by which they can earn their living and

In this HF provided training to 50 women who are already engaged in stitching, sewing, and remaking/redesigning of used cloths 50 men who are engaged in selling used cloths (lunda) and plastic utensils from door to door.

Moreover, 50 sewing machine and 50 washing machine with complete tool kit are provided as well as 50 hand carts are also provided to 50 men

### **Mangroves Reforestation and Conservation Project**

Hamdam Foundation (HF) implemented on year project entitled "Mangroves Reforestation and Conservation" project supported by UNDP GEF Small Grants Program Pakistan. Project aimed to reforest mangroves. Organizing local communities for the protection and enhancing participatory mangrove's resource management in coastal areas of Taluka Kharochan, District Thatta

### **Improving Socio- Economic Status of Women of Hyderabad: USAID**

HF implemented a project with the support of USAID Ambassador Fund project (December 2014 to 30 December 2015). The project aimed at developing vocational skills of women in Appliqué and Embroidery work. The 150 women were trained through two month short courses. The trainees were also oriented about marketable products, market demands and requirement. The women business associations were also formed for creating effective and sustainable market linkages.

### **Women Entrepreneur Development Programme**

For reducing the poverty and uplifting the standard of people and specially for empowering the women, the micro credit program has been launched collaboration with Orangi Pilot Project, Karachi (OPP). More than 20 million have been disbursed to 1500 beneficiaries. More than half of them are women in Baban Shah Colony (Kachi Abbadi), Bangali Colony, Hussainabad, Hyderabad and Jamshoro. Hamdam has made strategy to expand this programme to district Matyari in the next two years.


Women empowerment is primary concern of the SED programme. Under this programme women are also provided with skill development trainings and counseling for their business creation and career development.

### **Formal Education**

Realizing the community need of education, H has established Mashal Community Public School in Baban Shah Colony (Kachi abbadies) Hyderabad for providing quality education for the communities who cannot afford private education. The school provides quality education at lowest expenses. As of 30 March, quality education has been provided to 300 students.

### **Promotion of Integrated Health and Hygiene**

This project has been started with collaboration with Water Aid and Orangi Pilot Project (OPP/OCT) for promotion of health and hygienic conditions of marginalized communities. The overall objective of the programme is to promote health and hygienic conditions. The specific objectives of this programme are:

- To make community particularly women aware of health and hygiene
  - To create senses of health and hygiene among local communities particularly women and school children
  - To sensitize community about keeping their locality clean and neat

Hamdam foundations being one of the partner organizations of OPP and Water Aid, has been implementing this programme in two mohalla of Baban Shah Colony, Hyderabad.

### **Mother and Child Health Center (MCHC)**

Hamdam foundation established MCHC at Sheedi Goth, (Kachi abbadi) Hyderabad. The MCHC provides following services to communities:

- OPD services
- Antenatal and postnatal services
- Ultrasound facilities
- Immunization and Vaccination
- Family planning and counseling

### **Youth Advocacy Network Center**

Youth Advocacy Network Center was established with collaboration with **Marie Stops Society (MSS)** to create awareness among youth particularly females about reproductive health issues, hygiene and sexually transmitted disease so that they can play their role in promoting health and hygiene in localities.

### **Advocacy and Awareness raising on Tuberculosis, hepatitis- HIV-Aids in the Transgender and Prisoner**

The detailed awareness raising and information sharing activities arranged on human rights, socio-political issue, violence against women, gender related issues, reproductive health and violence issues, water, sanitation and environmental issues with collaboration with various organization. Hamdam foundation organized socio-psycho support to Transgender, Prisoners and Tuberculosis patients in Hyderabad District.

### **8. Hamdam Foundation's Flood Response Program**

Hamdam Foundation provided relief response in the areas of Medical, Shelter, Education, NFIs and Education to the flood affected population settled in camps, affected villages and spontaneous sites. In collaboration with IOM, UNICEF, SPO, OPP, NATPOW, Hamdam provided response to 3000 families. Initially they needed the relief work like as food items so Hamdam Foundation with the support of OPP, IOM, SPO and other organizations and individuals provided food items at the camps of gidu naka Hyderabad, labor squire Kotri, Opposite new court complex, Near Super Highway Jamshoro, Village Essa Shoro of Kotri, Union Council Allah Bachayo Shoro of Kotri, Khanpur village of Kotri. During the relief activities more than 2335 IDPs families of 19000 peoples provided the food items like as as Daal, Rice, Flour, Cooking oil, tea bags, Kitchen Masala and other items for fifteen days.

Hamdam Foundation also distributed the 100 tents along with NFIs kits (Included kitchen sets, 2 blankets and one Geri can) were distributed at village Shahmeer Daidano Union Council Manjhad District Jamshoro, 120 tents along with NFIs kits provided at the Budhapur village of Union Council Manjhand, 50 tents along with NFIs kits distributed among the IDPs at Khanoth Village near Manjhad town.

### **9 Shelter and NFI Support to flood affected people**

Hamdam foundation initially facilitated them immediate relief goods distribution as food and NFIs. After it, Hamdam Foundation provided temporary shelter as given them bamboos as support to make up a shadow upon them.

Hamdam Foundation in collaboration with OPP and IOM provided the initially shelter to more than 100 families comes from Shahdaskot, Jacobabad, Dadu, Jamshoro and other affected districts by providing them wooden Bamboos, ropes and plastic sheets (20/20 feet) as a result the shelter less families (751 peoples along with children) got shelter. After providing them temporary shelter, Hamdam Foundation (HF) in collaboration with International Organization for Migration (IOM) a Tent Village established at the Gulashan-e- Shahbaz near Super Highway Kotri where now 200 families are living under a shelter of tent. More than 1450 peoples are now enjoying their life frequently under shelter. In these tent village 4 women delivered babies and all medical treatment provided them at camp by Hamdam Foundation in collaboration with OPP. Also Non food items (NFI) like as kitchen kits are provided every family with Geri Can and other daily needed goods. Now in collaboration with International Organization for Migration tent village widened by 200 families. All 200 families provided tents.

Hamdam Foundation is implementing a Shelter for Poor project with the support of OPP-RTI in District Jamshoro. Hamdam Foundation is also the partner of the IOM for providing tents, NFIs and tent sheets to the flood affected people in Jamshoro district. Under OPP-RTI supported project, 200 shelters are being constructed in UC Allah Bachyao Shoro. Hamdam Foundation has distributed 700 permanent tents, 150 sheets, 150 Kitchen sets, 200 blankets are provided to the affected families with the support of IOM in village Budhapur, Shahmir Daidano, village Ghulam Mohammad Maher near Laki Shah Taluka Manjhand.

Under OPP-RTI project, HF is providing semi permanent shelter to the 500 poor families of UC Allah Bachyao Shoro Talukat Kotri. The shelter being built is comprised of one room with roof of thatched material and earthen walls.

Material used:

- Two Girder of 4X6X16 ft per room
- Bamboo Rods of 16 ft for Roof (13 rods) per room
- Patar (Sheet of Thatched Material)
- Plastic Sheet
- Earth Plaster

HF identified poor of the poorest families in the targeted UCs through detailed interviews with the communities and socio-economic survey. Identified families were registered and a MOU was signed with the registered families. Total 500 families were identified and registered. A community monitoring committee comprising of three members is formed in village Karo Khaho of the targeted UC to supervise the quality of the construction and material. A team of artisans is hired to construct the shelters of the registered beneficiaries. Upon completion of the shelter a receipt from beneficiary is taken in presence of two witnesses. HF in collaboration with IOM launched a pilot project of One Room Shelter at village Shahmeer Daidano of union council Manjhand district Jamshoro.
